

Proof of Residency

With the implementation of **HB22-1254/CRS 42-3-103 (4)(a)(III) effective 3/1/2023**, proof of Colorado residency is required to process Colorado title and/or registration for owners establishing Colorado residency. Below is a list of acceptable documentation:

Identification

- Colorado driver's license or identification card

Employment

- Pay stubs from an employer located in Colorado showing date of hire
- Signed letter from employer that is written on employer letterhead and verifies employment start date
- Signed job offer letter on employer letterhead

Ownership or Operation of a Business

- A copy of the owner's tax return (corporation or sole ownership)
- A copy of the Statement of Trade Name of an Individual form that the individual filed to establish the alternative business name (sole ownership)
- Articles of organization (for an LLC)

Identity or Housing (Start Date Required)

- Property tax receipt
- Utility bill indicating the utility service start date
- Lease/rental agreement that includes start date
- Deed of ownership for residence
- Voter registration card
- Colorado college/university enrollment papers or student ID card showing date of enrollment

Consult with a motor vehicle technician to determine what can be used to prove residency if you do not possess one of the documents listed above.
